Join by computer, smartphone or tablet



STEP 1: By computer:

Enter **zoom.us/join** in your web browser (Google, Explorer, Safari, etc.). You do not need to sign in or have an account to attend meetings.

By smartphone or tablet:

Enter **zoom.us** your web browser (Google, Explorer, Safari, etc.). Download and open the Zoom app or set up a free account.

STEP 2:

Enter the Meeting ID (and passcode if required) and click **Join**:

After joining the meeting, you may be prompted to "Join by Video" or "Join by Audio" so you can be seen and heard. Look for the small mic and camera icon to turn options on or off.

Join by telephone

(No video. voice only)



STEP 1:

Call one of the local access phone numbers provided by your Zoom host. Long distance rates may apply for non-local numbers.

STEP 2:

Enter the Meeting ID when the automated system prompts you.

STEP 3:

Press # to skip Participant ID and go to the next step.

Enter the passcode if required.

You may hear talking from other members who have already joined the meeting or you may need to wait until the host opens the full meeting for all.
