

Fire Prevention Central Monitoring Station Policy & Application

2024

PURPOSE:

The currently adopted International Building and Fire Codes, NFPA, Washington State Law, local ordinances, other applicable standards/laws, and administrative interpretations by the Fire Marshal govern the way in which fire protection is accomplished in the cities of Brier, Edmonds, Lynnwood, Mill Creek, and Mountlake Terrace. The Central Monitoring Station ("CMS") is a vital part of the fire protection system. In concert with construction methods, monitored fire protection systems provide early detection and response, minimizing life hazards and building loss.

CMS Monitoring Notifications:

The CMS shall notify the Fire Marshal daily of all conditions on monitored fire alarm systems. Clearly identify the condition:

- Alarms unrestored after 24 hours
- Supervisory unrestored after 24 hours
- Trouble signals unrestored after 24 hours
- Missed timer tests (24 hours)
- Loss of communications

Notifications shall be emailed to Prevention@SouthSnoFire.org until the system has been restored. Please do not fax email notifications to our headquarters.

The CMS shall provide the Fire Marshal and designees immediate access to appropriate personnel at the CMS via telephone (local or toll-free) to obtain system status updates and the ability to place the system on/off test. The CMS is also required to provide a cancellation notice to the Fire Marshal's Office (Prevention@SouthSnoFire.org) at least (10) days in advance of terminating a monitored account.

CMS Notification Format Requirements:

- The CMS company name and contact information shall be clearly visible on each notification
- The property name, address, condition, and zone shall be clearly indicated on each notification
